Our Juniors had their last Chill Skills class of the year. We had some new additions too. We recapped the structure of our classes - and why we do each step.

Move- they were hot already, so we did some easy easing in to the class

Play- pass the squeeze with how we feel and what would you throw into the pot for a class recipe for happiness (kindness, love, family time, being with a pet... etc). Stir it up and drink it!

Stretch-warriors for strength

Feel- peer story massage

Breathe- soft breaths breathing in through the nose quietly and deeply and slowly out through the mouth gently for relaxation (do This anytime)

Believe- affirmations for ourselves

Relax- I read a visualisation story to them, relaxing each muscle group progressively - they were very calm by the end of the class and a few who came in emotional left feeling much better. I reminded them to talk about their feelings and use their skills in the holidays.
