


Easter Grid

Choose an activity a day and have fun together! Take a photo of what you did and upload it onto SeeSaw!

Monday	Spell out SPRING by finding things that begin with each letter eg: S - sausages.	Send a hand made card to someone special. Did you post it?	Decorate boiled eggs for your snacks and share them with your family.	Paint a paper plate yellow and add some string legs. Then add a beak and eyes to your chick.	Make daffodil bunting! https://nurturystore.co.uk/daffodil-bunting
Tuesday	Make a small cone shape with coloured card or paper. Stick on a nose, ears and whiskers to make an Easter rabbit.	Using things you find in the garden (sticks, grass cuttings, leaves) spell the word EASTER.	Create an acrostic poem about Easter. Now decorate your poem with spring animals and plants.	Fill a balloon with water and play 'Catch the Easter Egg' with your family. Take a photo of the wettest!	Be a super hero for the day, what is your super power? Make a cape each and wear it all day.
Wednesday	Use felt tips to colour Easter eggs. Then paint over lightly with cooking oil and hang in the sunny position.	Write a Kindness poem. Thank everyone that is kind to you!	Draw an Easter egg shape and make patterns on it. Put it in your window to spread the cheer.	Play a board game together as a family.	Print hand prints on to card or paper and make them into rabbits.
Thursday	Cover a paper plate with cotton wool and add face and legs! Now you have an Easter lamb!	Make an Easter egg hunt but instead of chocolate eggs, write a message of kindness on paper ones!	Draw a small black dot in the middle of a piece of paper. What could your dot be? Now draw the rest of the picture.	Create an Easter egg tree to hang your eggs on. Use old twigs from the garden and a vase to hold them.	Complete a jig saw puzzle with a member of your family. Take a photo of your finished puzzle.
Friday	Play 'Hide and Tweet'. One person hides and makes 'tweeting' noises until they are found.	Use an eggshell to make a mini vase. Put some daisies from the garden in it and decorate your new vase.	Cut out an Easter egg shape from tin foil. Use felt tips to decorate it.	Organise an egg and spoon race, but don't cook the eggs! Which one smashes first?	What can you make from a cardboard box? A car, a house for a guinea pig? Take a photo of your construction.
