






## Describe an invention or discovery you would like to be known for.

If you could change one rule at school, which rule would it be and what would you change it to? Why did you choose that rule? Why is your rule better than the old one?






Write about the most valuable thing you have learned at school. Explain what made it so useful for you and how you can use it in life?

Think about something that annoys or bothers you. Write about what it is and why it bothers you. What can you do to make it less irritating?






Design a new and more efficient storage system to replace lockers in your school.
